**Under this agreement for 2017
Kingston State College will receive**

This funding will be used to

- Improve school attendance rate to >92% across whole school
- Improve NAPLAN Reading and Numeracy to >92% above NMS in years 7 and 9
- Improve NAPLAN Reading and Numeracy U2B to >10% of year 7 and year 9
- Embed Tactical Teaching of Reading (TTR) strategies across whole school curriculum
- Begin to implement across targeted faculties Tactical Teaching of Writing TTW.
- Ensure students with disabilities have access to rigorous curriculum and have individualised learning plans
- Ensure staff funded under the I4S agreement has access to necessary resourcing and Professional Development.
- Re-engage 'at risk' and disengaged students studying at the KLC in order to improve learning outcomes..

Our initiatives include

- Continue to develop a whole school approach to support Literacy/Reading across all learning areas using TTR strategies. Begin to embed TTW into lesson planning and teaching practices.
- Coach teachers in using Numeracy strategies across all learning areas
- Develop deeper understandings of data literacy and develop the leadership team and teachers in using data
- Maintain rigorous processes for tracking and monitoring attendance, engagement and outcomes for students in years 7 to 12 and ensure that all school leavers are exiting to a viable pathway.
- Continue to strengthen the case management approach to students who are on a QCE or QCIA pathway
- Improve access and effective use of Information Technology focusing upon individualised programs and inclusive practices 'at risk' and disengaged students accessing the KLC.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ a 0.8FTE Literacy Coach for Reading Improvement (\$110 000)
- Employ a 1.0FTE Numeracy Coach for Numeracy Improvement (\$120 000)
- Employ 2.0FTE teachers to allow year coordinators to track and monitor attendance (\$210 000)
- Employ 2 engagement teacher aides (35hrs per week) to focus upon attendance and re-engagement(\$56 000)
- Employ HOSES (band 5) for improved SWD outcomes (\$135 000)
- Resourcing for TTR, Impact lessons for U2B students and Professional Development for Teachers (\$90 000)
- Employ 2 Industry Liaison Officers (35 hrs per week) and additional Teacher Aide (5 hours per week) to track current year 12 students and to ensure past students are on track for a viable pathway. (\$63 000)
- Resources for Literacy and Numeracy, diagnostic testing and provision of IT for school funded staff (\$50 000)
- Purchase iPads, computers, provide professional development and necessary resources for KLC (\$108 000)
- Carried forward 2016 I4S funds will meet the shortfall of the 2017 total allocation of funds.
