

# STUDENT UNIFORM POLICY



The uniform code has been developed by students, teachers and parents and unanimously passed by the P&C Committee and will be strictly implemented. The complete school uniform must be worn to, from and at school.

- Year 7 – 10 students are expected to wear the polo/sports uniform.
- Year 11 and 12 students must wear formal uniform. Students may change for sports lessons and lunch. The students then change back into uniform for all other lessons. The Senior polo is an optional item.

<b>Jewellery</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Watch</li> <li>✓ Smart watches must have notifications switched off</li> <li>✓ Plain small studs or sleepers</li> <li>✓ Necklaces that are not visible</li> </ul>
<b>Make-up</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Natural looking foundation only</li> </ul>
<b>Nails</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Trimmed, natural nails</li> <li>✓ Clear nail polish only</li> </ul>
<b>Hair</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Hair must be neatly groomed</li> <li>✓ Natural hair colours only</li> </ul>
<b>Hat/cap</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ School cap or bucket hat with 'KSC'</li> <li>✓ Any other sun safe cap/hat</li> <li>✓ Plain black blue or white hijabs &amp; burka</li> <li>✗ Beanies are not allowed</li> </ul>
<b>School Bag</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Backpack style bags</li> <li>✓ Over the shoulder bags</li> </ul>
<b>Scarves</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Black &amp; light blue only</li> </ul>
<b>Socks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Black or white plain ankle length socks</li> </ul>
<b>Piercings</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ WHS compliant</li> </ul>

## Why We Have a Shoe Policy

To ensure the safety of all students and to support the delivery of the full Australian Curriculum in safe and practical learning environments, all students are required to wear fully enclosed **black leather shoes**.

### The right shoes protect you from:

- Heavy or sharp objects falling on feet
- Cuts and punctures from dropped tools or materials
- Burns from hot sparks, liquids, or chemicals
- Slips, trips, and falls caused by poor grip or open shoes

### What's NOT allowed:

- Thongs, sandals, slides, crocs, or open-toe shoes
- Mesh or fashion sneakers with holes

### Important to know:

- Workplace Health and Safety make this rule non-negotiable
- Medical certificates don't override safety laws – instead, the school will complete a risk assessment and adjust activities if needed
- For higher-risk activities (e.g. welding, metalwork, construction): steel-capped safety boots are required. Your teacher will advise if this is needed



# STUDENT UNIFORM POLICY



## Noncompliance with Dress Code

Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 Section 362 of the Act (1) If a student of a State school does not comply with a dress code, developed under section 360, the school's principal may only impose one of the following sanctions;

- Detention of the student for a period mentioned in section 283(3);
- Prevent the student from attending, or participating in, any activity for which the student would have been representing the school;
- Prevent the student from attending, or participating in, any school activity that, in the reasonable opinion of the school's principal, is not part of the essential educational program of the school.

## Non-Compliance Procedure

Student loan uniform will be maintained at the Student Services building and staffed by the Student Support Officer from 8:30 to 9:15 and 2:30 to 3:00. Students arriving out of uniform will be referred to Student Services.

## Loaning a Uniform

The students non-uniform item will be bagged and tagged

- Slip given to return to class
- Student returns end of the school day to return item

## Student Responsibility

- Report to Student Services before 8:30
- Return to Student Services at 2:45, not to leave class early

## Lesson 1 Teachers

- Check dress code
- If a parent note is provided student still goes to Student Services to change
- Refer students to Student Services
- If a student refuses to follow instruction, document and follow referral pathway

## Lesson 4 Teachers

- Release students with uniform notes at 2:45 to return items
- Not to be released early

## All Teachers

- Students out of uniform at any time during the school day must be referred to Student Services

## Student Support Officer

- Record student referred for uniform on ID Attend
- Issue uniform with collection slip
- Tag and bag student's item for collection
- Contact home for any non-returned items

## Uniform Misconduct

- Student Services, monitors the uniform misconduct register and issues consequences in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct
